Category R Vessel checklist

Recreational under 9m

Please NOTE: This form is here to assist you with gathering the correct equipment for your survey and must be used in conjunction with the relevant and completed SAMSA survey form. (SUR-701-02-09 Safety Survey Category R (Non-passenger Pleasure))

- A SAMSA approved life jacket or buoyancy aid for each person on the boat
- 1 x 1.5kg dry powder fire extinguisher per motor. This has to be serviced annually by a
 SAMSA approved facility.
- Tools suitable for minor repairs
- Spares for minor repairs (cable ties, fuses, insulation tape, plugs etc.)
- Capsize rope (only for inflatables and ski-boats)
- A suitable anchor for your area of operation
- Anchor chain of 3m of 6mm galvanised chain for vessels less than 6m
- The anchor rope must to be at least 30m
- First Aid kit including a first aid manual
- Suitable bailing device if your vessel doesn't have a wet deck
- Two paddles or oars. (single motors only)
- Inflatable's to have air bellows and repair kit
- Red flag (for Skiing)
- Kill switch/s
- One waterproof torch (Only required if your boat is operated at night)
- All safety equipment to be on board and marked with your boats number
- Emergency steering attachment on the motor (demonstrate its operation)
- Emergency steering attachment arm
- Registration number on both sides of the vessel/craft (min 75mm high)

- The boat trailer has to be marked with boat's number and the owner's name and telephone number
- Petrol tanks to be S.A.M.S.A approved
- Bow eye and stern eye
- For night operation, the boat must be equipped with navigation lights and an all-round white light.
- Copy Buoyancy certificate
- Copy Skipper's Licence
- Motor/motors annual service report
- Vessel must be trailered for her survey
- SAMSA survey list completed (SUR-701-02-09 Safety Survey Category R (Non-passenger Pleasure))
