Please NOTE: This form is here to assist you with gathering the correct equipment for your survey and must be used in conjunction with the relevant and completed SAMSA survey form. (SUR-701-02-06 Safety Survey Category E)

- SAMSA approved life jacket or buoyancy aid for each person on the boat
- 1 x 1.5kg dry powder fire extinguisher per motor. This has to be serviced annually
 by a SAMSA approved facility
- Tools suitable for minor repairs
- Spares for minor repairs (cable ties, fuses, insulation tape, plugs etc.)
- Capsize rope (only for inflatables and ski-boats)
- Proper patent anchor suitable for the area
- □ Anchor chain: Vessel under 6m in length at least 3m of 6mm chain
- □ Anchor chain: Vessel over 6m in length at least 5m of 6mm chain
- Anchor rope: at least 50m of suitable anchor rope
- A suitable Sea Anchor rigged for surf launching with trip line and hawser
 (Surf Launch only)
- □ Kill switch/s
- Emergency / Alternative Steering
- Two paddles or oars (If only one motor)
- Inflatable's to have air bellows and repair kit.
- One water tight capsize bottle with a lanyard 1.5 times the length of the boat
 readily accessible in the event of capsize and to contain the following:

- □ 1 x In-date projectile flare set with a minimum of 6 flares
- □ 1 x In-date hand held smoke marker
- □ 1 x first aid kit including a first aid manual
- □ 1 x waterproof torch complete with spare batteries and spare bulb (only if you use the river at night)
- All safety equipment to be on board and marked with boats number
- Emergency steering attachment on the motor (demonstrate its operation)
- Emergency steering attachment arm
- Fuel tanks to be S.A.M.S.A approved
- Registration number on both sides of the vessel/craft
- For night operation, the boat must be equipped with navigation lights and an all-round white light (This would only be for river use)
- Anchor bollard
- Bow eye and stern eye
- Suitable scuppers
- The boat trailer to be marked with boat's number and the owner's telephone number.
- Battery and fuel tank to be in separate compartments.
- Copy Buoyancy certificate
- Copy Skipper's Licence
- Motor/motors annual service report
- Vessel must be trailered for her survey
- SAMSA Safety survey checklist Category E completed
